
I am deeply thankful to you

I believe and hope that for the next five years, we won't hear much about EVMs. However, when we go to the polls again in 2029, they might start their drama



about the EVMs once more. Their chances of reform are very slim. During the election, I saw for the first time that almost every third day, the Supreme Court was approached to obstruct the work of the Election Commission. Various applications were filed by the same group, who have a deep distrust of democracy, making continuous efforts to create obstacles through the Supreme Court. A significant portion of the Election Commission's strength was tied up in the courts during peak election hours, revealing their deep frustration. Their entire attack was aimed at the institution so that no matter the election results, they could discredit India globally. This was part of their conspiracy, friends, and the country will never forgive them.

Friends, when the INDI alliance opposes the EVMs, I don't see it as just an election issue. I believe these people have a mindset rooted in the previous century. They neither understand nor accept the importance of technology. This opposition was evident not only with EVMs but also with UPI. When we said that the people of India will adopt digital transactions and today, India has made a name for itself in the fintech world, they didn't accept it. Aadhaar has become the identity of the country. Many countries ask me how they can adopt the Aadhaar system. But to obstruct Aadhaar, they repeatedly approached the Supreme Court, causing difficulties. Essentially, they are against progress, modernity, and technology. We've seen this with the INDI alliance.

Diversity, vastness, and depth of India's democracy

Friends, it's concerning that efforts are being made to undermine the strength of India's democracy on the global stage. While I'm proclaiming that we are the mother of democracy, they are going around telling the world that there's no democracy in our country, questioning how a tea seller like Modi reached this position, suggesting there must have been some foul

play. Their mindset is to create distrust among Indian citizens about the electoral process. I believe that the world will now be more interested in understanding the diversity, vastness, and depth of India's democracy. This election result is a testament to that.

Friends, between the completion of voting on the 1st and the counting on the 4th, there were planned statements inciting violence in the country. Some might not take this seriously, but it is very serious. First, they disrespect the electoral system, and then, before the results, they create an atmosphere of chaos. Their words implied setting the country on fire. They continuously tried to mislead the country and divide the people. Elections are a festival of democracy meant to unite as many people as possible, not to

divide them. But every effort was made to do just that.

Friends, democracy teaches us to respect everyone. I congratulate the MPs from the opposition who won. In the last ten years, I missed the quality of debate and participation in Parliament. I hope the







India. On one hand. Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi became the first ever Prime Minister in the last 62 years to return to power for the third time in a row after serving two full terms. However, on the other hand, the Congress-led opposition- INDI alliance also faced a hattrick drubbing and despite all its tries and tricks the Congress couldn't touch the three-digit figure in the Lok Sabha.

The BJP-led NDA has secured an absolute majority in the 2024 Lok Sabha elections by winning 292 seats. The BJP alone has won 240 seats. Its allay, Telugu Desam has secured 16 seats and JD(U) 12 seats.

Whereas, the I.N.D.I.A bloc has bagged 233 seats, others have won 18 seats in the lower house of Parliament. The Congress secured 99 seats. Samajwadi Party got 37 seats while Trinamool Congress 29. DMK managed to win 22 seats.

This election has also been special for the BJP

as it has received a record mandate by the people of Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh and Odisha. The vote share of the BJP has almost doubled in Telangana and won a Lok Sabha seat first time in Kerala.

Prominent candidates who have won massively include Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi from Varanasi, Shri Rajnath Singh from Lucknow, Shri Amit Shah from Gandhinagar, Shri Nitin Gadkari from Nagpur, Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan from Vidisha, Shri Om Birla from Kota.

Sweeping victory in States

As per the results by the Election Commission, the BJP secured 240 seats and the BJP-led National Democratic Alliance (NDA) secured 292 seats and emerged as the largest alliance in the Lok Sabha.

This result puts the BJP well ahead of the Congress, the largest opposition party, which secured 99 seats. The BJP has won significantly in the 2024 Lok Sabha elections with sweeping victories in five states.

The NDA has secured all seats in Madhya Pradesh (29 seats), Himachal Pradesh (4 seats), Delhi (7 seats), Uttarakhand (5 seats), and Tripura (2 seats).

Last time the BJP won all Lok Sabha seats in these states excluding Madhya Pradesh. This time, Madhya Pradesh is a new addition to the BJP's list of swept states, with the party winning the Chhindwara seat, previously contested by Congress's Nakul Nath.


The BJP also performed strongly in Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, and Odisha. In Chhattisgarh, the party secured 10 out of 11 seats. In Gujarat, the BJP won 25 seats out of 26. The BJP also won 20 out of 21 seats in Odisha, while the Biju Janata Dal (BJD) and Congress secured one seat each.

MADHYA PRADESH

In Madhya Pradesh, BJP has made clean sweep by winning all 29 seats. Shri Shankar Lalwani of the BJP has won Indore seat by a margin of 11,75,092 votes against his nearest rival Sanjay of Bahujan Samaj Party. BJP senior leader Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan won from Vidisha Lok Sabha constituency by a whopping 8,21,408 votes, defeating his nearest Congress rival. From Guna seat, Shri Jyotiraditya Scindia has won with over five lakh votes margin, Shri Rahul Singh Lodhi has won form Damoh with



over 4 lakh votes margin, Shri Faggan Singh Kulaste bagged Mandla seat. Shri Bunty Vivek Sahu won the Chhindwara seat. BJP contested on all 29 seats in Madhya Pradesh, while Congress contested on 27 seats.

HIMACHAL PRADESH

In Himachal Pradesh, the BJP has won all four Lok Sabha seats. With this clean sweep, the BJP

has repeated the history of 2014 and 2019. In Himachal Pradesh, notable wins include Shri Anurag Thakur, who secured the Hamirpur seat for the fifth consecutive time. Actor Kangana Ranaut and Shri Rajiv Bharadwaj made their political debuts from Mandi and Kangra seats, respectively, while former BJP state President Shri Suresh Kashyap retained his Shimla seat

DELHI

Like in 2014 & 2019, in Delhi, the BJP has won on all seven seats. Bansuri Swaraj, Shri Praveen Khandelwal, Shri Ramvir Singh Bidhuri, Shri Manoi Tiwari, Shri Harsh Malhotra, Shri Kamaljeet Sehrawat and Shri Yogendra Chandoliya won from Delhi.

UTTARAKHAND

In Uttarakhand, the BJP has won all five Lok Sabha seats in the state. BJP candidate Shri Ajay Bhatt defeated Congress rival by a margin of more than 3 lakh votes in Nainital-Udhamsingh Nagar. Shri Trivendra Singh Rawat of BJP has won from Haridwar seat defeating Congress candidate by a margin of over 1 lakh 64 thousand votes. Shri Anil Baluni registered a win by a margin of over 1 lakh 63 thousand votes in Garhwal.

TRIPURA





GUJARAT

In Gujarat, the BJP has registered a massive win by securing 25 seats out of total 26. One seat has gone to the Congress. Union Home Minister Shri Amit Shah won in Gandhinagar, while BJP State President Shri C.R Patil won in Navsari. Union Minister Shri Mansukh Mandaviya also won in Porbandar.

ODISHA

In Odisha, BJP has made the impressive show as

it won 20 Lok Sabha seats while the Congress just managed to win a single seat. BJD failed to open its account. The State also witnessed its State Assembly election simultaneously where the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), Biju Janata Dal (BJD) and Indian National Congress (INC) are main contenders. NDA ally, TDP has won 16 seats, the BJP won 3 seats, the Jan Sena Party has won two seats respectively while the YSRCP got four seats. BJP senior leaders Smt. Daggubati Purandheshwari won from Rajahmundry, Shri C.M.Ramesh won from Anakapalle and Shri Bhupathi Raju Srinivasa Varma won from Narsapuram respectively.

KARNATAKA

KERALA





14 seats. The BJP won eight seats with a 44.60 vote share, AJSU Party -one, JMM-three and the Congress two. Among the senior BJP leaders of the state, Union Minister Smt. 



In Goa, out of the two seats the BJP has won the North Goa seat while the Congress has won the South Goa seat. The BJP got a vote share of 50.79 per cent and senior leader & Union Minister Shri Shripad Yesso Naik won the North Goa seat by a huge margin.

Andaman and Nicobar Islands

In Andaman and Nicobar Islands, the BJP candidate Shri Bishnu Pada Ray won the lone Parliamentary seat and the BJP got a vote share of 50. 59 per cent.

Dadra-Nagar Haveli & Daman-Diu

BJP stormed to power in Odisha

The BJP stormed to power in the recently-concluded Assembly elections, ending 24 years of rule of the Naveen Patnaik-led Biju Janata Dal (BJD) by securing 78 of 147 seats with a vote share of 40.07 per cent. While the BJD got 51 seats, Congress secured 14, CPI(M) won one seat and Independents got three.

The counting of votes is being held in 70 centres. This time, over 2.5 crore voters exercised their franchise, with a turnout of 74.44 per cent, up from 2019. Genderwise, 75.55 per cent of women and 73.37 per cent of men voted in the 2024 state election.

The state witnessed a high-voltage campaign led by Shri PM Shri Narendra Modi himself addressing 10 poll rallies besides holding two road shows in Bhubaneswar and Puri. The BJP central leaders held at least 245 election meetings across the state.

Apart from Shri Modi, top party leaders like Shri JP Nadda, Shri Rajnath Singh, Shri Amit Shah, Shri Nitin Gadkari and others campaigned in the assembly election.


The polling for 32 assembly seats in Sikkim was held on April 19, 2024 in the first phase simultaneously with the Lok Sabha elections. This is the third time, Sikkim has witnessed a landslide victory of a political party as similar results were drawn by Sikkim Sangram Parishad and SDF in 1989 and 2009 respectively. In the 2019 assembly elections, the SKM won 17 seats, while the SDF secured 15 seats out of the 32 seats. SKM won 10 seats in 2014 as it faced its first assembly elections.




